DIAMOND SOLITAIRE RING

One modern-style 18 carat yellow gold and platinum diamond solitaire ring with a flat shank and flat sides. Band is handmade brushed in yellow gold, setting is cast CAD designed polished in platinum. The setting is round shaped 6.12 mm in diameter raised attached to the top of the band. Diamond is in a rubover full bezel mount. The band measures 2.60 mm in width and 1.90-1.95 mm in thickness. The ring is a size O. The ring weighs a total of 5.30 grams. The metals were tested and determined to be platinum and 18 carat yellow gold. Stamped "18CT" and "PLAT". The "fili" trademark (or hallmark) can also be found on the item. In new condition.

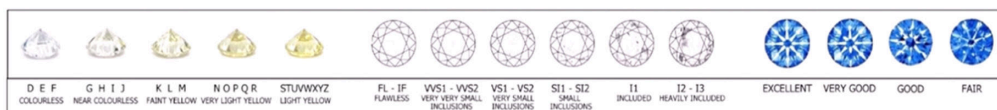

Metals, diamonds & gemstones described in this report have been tested using non-destructive modern methods, XRF, PL, Raman, IR spectrometers as well as traditional gemmological instruments, reference master stones/ charts etc. to assist in the detection of synthetics, treatments, grading etc.

Any anomalies will be reported. However, most gemstones undergo some form of treatment, many of which are acceptable trade practices. Only those treatments deemed unacceptable (under international CIBJO regulations, to which NZ is a signatory) will be noted.

We do not remove any diamonds/ gemstones from their settings, so unless reported, we can only estimate their weights by calculation.

The GIA grading system is used to describe diamonds in this report/ valuation. (see below)
Coloured gems are described as used by Gemworld, featured in their Gemguide pricing system.



Watches:

We generally do not open the backs of watches, as this can damage seals and void any warranty the watch may have. Therefore, authenticity is checked by the following methods:

1. Visually - comparing quality of finish, measurements and weights against known models.
2. We use Watch certification Services of America, which compares model number and serial number against known counterfeits.
3. Metal analysis - using XRF to determine the case/ bracelet alloys against a database of known models.

Whilst all care is taken to check the genuineness of any watch, the ultimate authority for deeming a watch as genuine is the manufacturer. In no way does this valuation report guarantee authenticity.
